Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943. They began as a small machine shop at first employing four individuals. Sales for their first year of operation amounted to about sixty thousand dollars. The first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and other components. Throughout five years of operation, the company had stretched to 40 staff and their yearly sales volume had risen to \$330,000. Nowadays, Cascade is amongst the top worldwide makers in the material handling industry.

Manufacture and design of the company's original hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive pursuit of better business opportunities. During the past 60 years, the material handling trade has grown into a highly advanced field and Cascade has proudly performed a part in this growth. Cascade at present continues to develop as the premier provider of lift truck attachments and different related products. The business feels assured in their potential to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding customer's needs in the future and remaining aggressive within the world market.

During the nineteen fifties, Cascade began to fabricate, design, and advertise its hydraulic accessories. A brand new facility was made in 1956, so as to accommodate all of the plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which remains to be the company's present head office. Following fifteen years of business, total employees reached one hundred eighty employees and sales had reached practically 2.3 million dollars.

In the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio the next manufacturing plant was built. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's preliminary move into the international world of the material handling industry as the company recognized interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

The business altered its name to Cascade Corporation in 1964. In the year 1965, Cascade went public with a preliminary offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. The company has expanded its production facilities within the U.S. with locations in Warner Robins, Georgia, Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Ohio. Cascade products are manufactured globally due to many subsidiary operations. In 1994, a new facility was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This facility is designed to be the ultimate customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in 1996 and the year 1997 subsequent to acquiring 5 corporations, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the international leader in blades.
